## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well has a total depth of 3061'. Of 2860' of oil string, 854' was left in well. Heavy mud was run from bottom to 2006' where pipe was salvaged and plug of 15 sacks of cement was set. Heavy mud was run to bottom of surface pipe at 585' and plug of 5 sacks of cement was set and mud run to surface. A 5 sack plug of cement was set and regulation marker was placed and location cleared.
