On August 4, 1942 on the above well the 6 5/8" casing was run and set at 2772' cementing with 200 sacks of cement. After the cement had set 72 hours the plug was drilled. On August 7, 1942 after the plug was drilled and test was made for the water shut off which was complete. This information was taken from the tour sheets of Brewer Drilling Co., Artesia, New Mexico, the drilling contractor.
