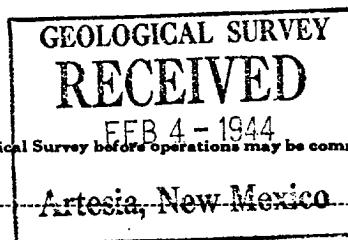
DETAILS OF WORK

We set 120 ft of 8 1/2" Liner, through the Red Sand, from 2227 ft to 2347 ft and cemented with 75 sacks of cement. Let set for 72 hours then drilled plug and tested. Results-- hole dry.

Work was done by International Cementers, Inc. on January 24, 1944.

Drilled plug and tested cement on January 27, 1944.
