DETAILS OF WORK

Since we have drilled well to a total depth of 3400 ft and there has been no production encountered, we propose to pull 2827 ft of 7" O. D. Casing and then will fill hole with heavy mud to 1195 ft (base of Salt); then will run wooden plug to 1205 ft and will cement with 15 sacks of cement and will let set for 72 hours. We will then notify U. S. Geological Survey to witness plug and test.

We propose to fill hole with mud back to the bottom of 10" casing at 543 ft then will run wooden plug to 548 ft and will cement with 10 sacks of cement; then will fill with hole to Surface and will weld cap on 10" casing. (No 10" Casing will be salvaged) Will erect U. S. Geological Survey Regulation marker.
