DETAILS OF WORK

Total Depth of Well--3375 ft.

We pulled 7" O. D. Casing, and filled hole with heavy mud to 1195 ft (base of Salt), then ran wooden plug to 1205 ft and cemented with 15 sacks of cement back to 1150 ft. Let set for 72 hours and then notified the U. S. Geological Survey to witness and test plug. Results-- plug tested satisfactory. We filled hole back to 595 ft and then ran wooden plug to 548 ft and cemented with 10 sacks of cement; then filled hole to Surface with heavy mud and welded cap on 10" Casing. (There was no 10" Casing salvaged.) We erected U. S. Geological Survey Regulation marker.

Work was completed on February 29, 1944.
