Pressure tested 4-1/2" casing at 700 psi for 30 minutes. No loss in pressure. Drilled plug and circulated hole clean to TD of 2706' GR. Ran GR-N log. Fraced with 10,000 gallons brine water and 10,000# sand at 29 BPM at 2200 psi. Installed pumping equipment. On December 21, 1969, well pumped 2.3 BO & 40 BW in 24 hours.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
