Gentlemen:

You have shown production on your Form C-115 Report of Monthly Production and Pipeline Runs for the month of May, 1954, for the above mentioned well.

The Proration Office at Hobbs has no record of this well ever having been on the proration schedule, and we do not have any record of the well in the Artesia Office of the Oil Conservation Commission. Also, I have checked with Mr. Van S. Walsh, who drilled this well on federal lands some years ago, and he informs me that the well never had produced.

It appears that you are producing this well in violation of Rule 504, Para. (B), of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules and Regulations. If this is true, you must file Form C-104 Request for Oil Allowable and Form C-110 Certificate of Compliance and Authorization to Transport Oil, and submit forms C-104 and C-110 in quadruplicate to the Artesia Office of the Oil Conservation Commission for approval. The Proration Manager will then assign an allowable for your well.

We are enclosing the necessary forms under separate cover. If this office can be of any further help in clearing up this matter, please let us hear from you.
