The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 3765 ft.

DETAILS OF PLAN OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

3460 feet of 2 1/2 inch tubing run in hole. Well flowing through tubing by allowing gas from 2895 feet and 2962 feet to pass around through the tubing thereby forcing well to flow. Due to the small amount of gas in the well, this method produces ~~the~~ by far, the best results.

APPROVED as follows:

1. That the 2 1/2" tubing not be pulled from the well without approval.
2. If the well is produced without the tubing in the well it will be necessary to set (mud or cement) a string of casing between 3300 and 3550'.
