DETAILS OF WORK

We desire approval to drill Jackson 14-A to approximately 3500 feet, hoping to encounter lime pay producing to the south. If we do, we propose to set oil string on top of lime pay; acidize and perhaps frac; then set bridging plug between pay and any upper sand pay expected to be found at about 3050 feet; perforate and frac that pay; knock out bridging plug and put well on production. 8-5/8" will be run to the top of the salt estimated at about 500 feet and cemented to surface.

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I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

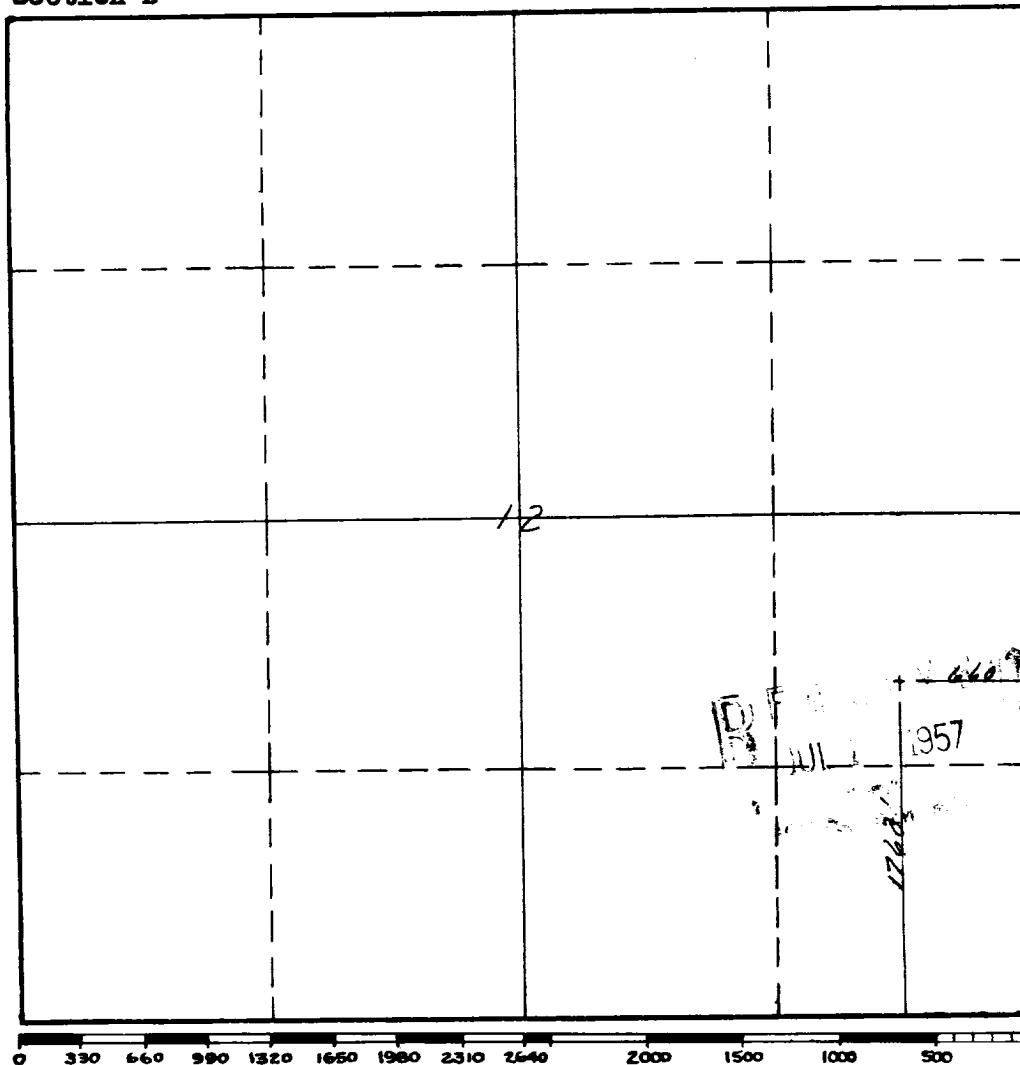
