Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of Nevember 28, 1967, requesting an exception to the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit producing the Grayburg zone of your Grayburg Jackson San Andres Unit Well No. 38, located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 12, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, into the tank battery located in the SE/4 of Section 1. same township, which handles Grayburg production from the Square Lake Pool underlying your Jackson "B" Lease in the SE/4 of said Section 1. It is our understanding that the subject Well No. 38 was dually completed and equipped with two strings of tubing in order to segregate Grayburg and San Andres production, although they are in the same pool, because the San Andres zone only is unitized, and ownership of the two zenes is therefor not common. We assume that the comership of the Grayburg zone in the subject well is common with the Grayburg zone of the Jackson "B" Lease in Section 1.
