On July 16, 1973, 4½" liner was re-perforated at 3381-87 with 14 holes and at 3421, 3437, 3442, 3447, 3452, 3456, 3467, 3472, 3491 and 3495 with 2 holes per foot. On July 17, 1973, these perforations were acidized with 1,000 gallons of 20% XLF acid 50# J-227 diverting plug. Treated at 2000 psi. at .88 BPM. On July 27, 1973, well is taking 200 barrels of fresh water per day at 1500 psi., so it appears that injectivity has been improved. The well previously took 70 bbls. salt water per day.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations; and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
