This well is pumping about 11 BO + 25 BWPD. It is proposed to stimulate by treating below a Lynes packer set at about 3,040', with 8,000 gals. 20% HCL + 10,500# FLA-100 sand + 15,000 gals. Redifrac gel, all containing corrosion inhibitor and ProtexAll for scale inhibition. This will be in 3 stages, using 100# benzoic acid flakes + 200# rock salt plugs between stages.

Instructions
