Preliminary conversion work was reported on form dated August 15, 1967.

Subsequently, the hole was plugged back to 3450' with 31 gallons of gravel and 6 gallons of hydromite. An umbrella bridge was set at 3342' and 5' of gravel and 5' of cal seal were dumped to 3332'. On Nov. 21, ran 15 joints of 4 1/2" O.D. 9.5# J-55 casing (490') and cemented with 100 sacks of incor cement. Top of liner is at 2842'. Reversed out 12 bbls. of cement. Tested top of liner with 1,000 psi. and pressure held. On Nov. 28, 1967, drilled out plugs to 3439'. Ran 2-3/8" O.D. upset tubing internally coated with plastic and set Baker AD tension packer at 2860'. Resumed water injection on Nov. 30, 1967.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
