**This water injection well has been injecting since 1967, and is presently
injecting only 20 barrels per day at a pressure of 1725 psi. Remedial work in this
well has consisted of both acidizing and shooting with SNG. A total of 134,126
barrels of water have been injected, and we believe that the usefulness of this
well as an injector is of no value.**

**It is proposed to convert the well to a producer to produce from the
interval 3280-3500'. Back-up for the flood will be accomplished by Unit well #23,
which is taking 150 barrels per day.**
