1. Pull rods and tubing.
2. Clean out to total depth.
3. Run 4 1/2" liner from 2,790' to total depth and cement in place.
4. Perforate Grayburg-Jackson and Premier Zones in selected intervals.
5. Run 2 3/8" O.D. internally plastic coated tubing with necessary packers and bottom hole flow regulators to dually inject into Grayburg-Jackson and Premier Zones.
6. Hook up well head for injection.

Note: Work will be performed in accordance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-4133 (Case No. 4521).

Instructions
