Mr. Ramey,

Southland Royalty Company respectfully requests an exception to Rule 705A for the above-captioned shut-in injection well in our Parke Area waterflood. This well was shut in during 1979 due to direct communication with its south offset, Parke "A" Tr. 1 Well #3 which was subsequently TA'd with a Cast Iron Bridge Plug. A map and diagrammatic wellbore sketch of Parke B Tr. B Well #1 are attached. Since there were no other producers in the area, there was no reason to resume injection into the subject well.

We initiated development of our Parke waterflood on 20-acre spacing this year by drilling four wells and will continue infill drilling in 1982. Since this well will not fit our planned waterflood pattern, we will move in the near future to recomplete as a Seven Rivers gas producer, plug and abandon, or use as an off-spot injector.
