## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

## FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

The above described well had not produced any oil for the past four months. We propose to pull what casing we can recover, and plug and abandon it. After pulling the casing, we expect to put in a light shot of nitroglycerin at about 2300 feet, and thereafter at 100 foot intervals until we can begin to recover 7" oil.

We propose to mud from 3500' to 3270'; then run cement plug from 3270' to 3240'; then mud to 3140'; then cement from 3140' to 3110'; then mud to 1665'; then cement plug to 1650'; then mud to surface. Ten foot steel marker, four inches in diameter in concrete.

Exact date of beginning plugging operations will be given when we learn when we can get hydraulic pulling machine to move in. Unable to give exact date at present.
