1. Rigged up pulling unit, pulled rods and tubing.
2. Drilled 118' deeper in the Grayburg (Metex to Premier). New T.D. 2985'.
3. Set 125' of 4 1/2", 10.5#, FS-40 Atlas Bradford liner from 2985' to 2859'; cemented with 40 sx Class H w/2% CaCL, .2 of 1% CFR-2, 5# salt/sack and 5# sand/sack. Circulated excess cement to pit by pumping down tbg.
4. Ran Gamma Ray Compensated Neutron Log; perforated Premier zone 2916-26 and 2932-36 @ 2 SPF; perforated Metex zone 2782-90, 2814-24 and 2848-52 @ 2 SPF.
5. Acidized perfs 2916-2936 w/11 bbls. 15% NE acid; acidized perfs 2782-2790 w/6 bbls acid; acidized perfs 2814-52 w/20 bbls acid.

Fracced 2916-2936 w/250 gals 15% NE acid, 20,000 gals gelled water, 6,000# 100 mesh sand, 15,500# 20/40 sand, 3,000# 10/20 sand & 50#Gypban.
Fracced 2782-52 w/750 gals 15% NE acid, 52,670 gals gelled water, 18,000# 100 mesh sand, 33,500# 20/40 sand, 12,000# 10/20 sd & 150#Gypban.

6. Washed sand out after frac, reran rods and tubing with 3 N set @ 2952'. Returned well to production. Note: Prod. prior to W. O. = 1 Bo & 0 BWPd.

Instructions
