Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of October 5, 1961, wherein you request permission to commingle the production from the Grayburg Jackson pool underlying five separate State leases, namely the B-2209, B-8095, B-8838, B-936, and B-1483, all in Section 16./Township 17/South, Range 30/East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Before we can authorise such commingling, it will be necessary for you to comply with Rule 309-B, and furnish us with a schematic drawing of the commingling installation, showing thereon that you will have adequate facilities for testing the various wells at reasonable intervals. You will also have to furnish the Commission with evidence that all persons owning an interest in the leases and the purchaser of the production have consented in writing to the commingling. In lieu of this last requirement, you may furnish evidence that all such parties were notified by certified or registered mail of your intent, in whichcase it will be necessary for us to wait 20 days before approving the commingling, in order to allow time for any such interested party to object.
