Also, in order for the Artesia Pipe Line Company to run the condensate produced with the gas, you must make your request for an estimated number of barrels by letter to Mr. A. L. Porter, Jr., Proration Manager, P. O. Box 2045, Hobbs, New Mexico, not later than the first day of each month and he will then issue a supplement to the proration schedule authorizing the pipe line company to transport the estimated amount of condensate for the current month.
