Well was treated on April 18, 1956 by The Western Company using 29,000 pounds of sand and 19,000 gallons of oil. Total free oil and load oil was 689 barrels. The Recovery of the load oil was completed on May 31, 1956. During the first 24 hours after recovery of load oil, the well produced 14 barrels of free oil by pumping.

Total depth of well 3,256 feet. Treatment from 3,000 feet to 3,256 feet.
