Pursuant to telephone conversation with Mr. Knauf August 14, 1968, we plan to perforate and acidize additional section from 6780-6750'. This section on drillstem test flowed 310 MCFGPD and reversed out 19 80.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
