Production from present perforations 6742' - 6798' in the Abo reef has declined to the economic limit of 12 BW and 145 BW per day. Pursuant to telephone conversations with Mr. Kneuf Jan. 19, we plan to set a wire line bridge plug with 35' of cement on top at 6738 feet on top of the Abo reef and recomplate the well in the San Andres through perforations at selected intervals from 3350' to 3450'. This zone produced oil while drilling with air. The 5 1/2" csg. was set at 6815' with 750 sack of cement. A temperature survey showed the top of the cement 100' from surface.

Instructions
