It is our intention to reactivate this well to dispose of produced salt water into the Abo formation of this well with injection into the existing perforated intervals from approximately 6,760' to 6,778' and from approximately 6,810' to 6,832'. Injection will be accomplished through the 5 1/2" casing. The present casing program shown below should be adequate to protect all oil-bearing and water-bearing strata:

8 5/8" casing set at 1850' with cement circulated to surface
5 1/2" casing set at 6840' with cement circulated to surface
(T.D. 6840')

Utilization of this well as a salt water disposal well was previously approved by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico by their Order No. R-3617. We request your approval to resume use of this well as a salt water disposal well.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
