3-7-66 The Western Company jet perforated 4" casing from 6652' to 6660', 6677' to 6686', 6702' to 6706', and 6713' to 6716' with 2 shots per foot.

3-8-66 Using packer and retrievable bridge plug we selectively acidized new perforations with 5000 gallons 15% HCl acid.

3-11-66 Pulled packer & bridge plug out of hole and ran pumping equipment back in to produce from both old and new perforations.

3-28-66 Well made 7 bbls. oil in 24 hours. Before treatment well was making approx. 4 bbls. per day.

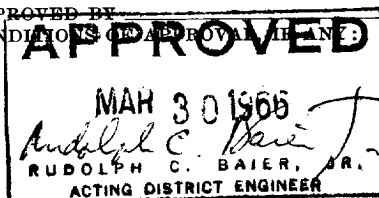

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
