This well has not produced since Feb. 1967 due to high lifting costs. Because of recompletion possibilities in the Grayburg, Premier, Lovington, Jackson, and San Andres zones, we would like to retain the temporarily abandoned status until these zones can be tested. We have about completed the paper work for these zones behind the pipe and field work should begin within the next 12 months.

The present condition of the well is such as to prevent damage to the producing zone, migration of hydrocarbons or water, the contamination of fresh water or other natural resources, or the leakage of any substance at the surface.
