Administrative Order OLS-23

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the telephone conversation of March 16, 1966, between Mr. R. R. Aston of your office and Mr. D. S. Mutter of this office regarding temporary authority to construct a tank battery for your Brigham Well No. 1 located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, on the lease immediately north which is owned by another operator. It is our understanding that the location of the tank battery in the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 21 is necessitated by a highway which traverses the forty-acre track upon which the subject well is located. It is our further understanding that the owner of the lease immediately north as well as the United States Geological Survey have consented to your proposed off-lease storage.

You are hereby authorized to construct and operate a tank battery as described above on a temporary basis for a period not to exceed 30 days. Upon receipt of a formal application in accordance with Rule 309-C, consideration will be given to the issuance of a permanent off-lease storage order.
