Well was spudded Nov. 4th. 1926 - Drilling completed March 27th. 1927 continuous operations from top to present total depth of 3457 feet.

In attempting to remove 10" casing preparatory to shooting gas sand encountered from 1812 ft. to 1818 ft., casing parted leaving 147 ft. of casing in the hole, every reasonable and possible endeavor to recover this 147 ft. of casing by continuous fishing from March 29th. to May 26th., was made. - It is now located in the hole from 1857 ft. to 2004 ft., inside, at the bottom of which is a complete string of fishing tools consisting of - 10" Trip Casing Spear - 36" stroke fishing jars - 32' X 4-1/2" Stem and - Wire line rope socket, from which all cable was cut and removed from the hole.
