DETAILS OF WORK

Confirming verbal conversation of J.L. Briscoe to John A. Frost at United States Geological Survey in Artesia, New Mexico.

January 22, 1952, we will run new 8 5/8" casing instead of the original 10" stated in the Intention to Drill Notice.

On January 25, 1952, we set 552' of new 8 5/8" casing-8 Rd. Thd., using 50 sacks of cement mixed with salty water and 10 sacks of aquagel. Mud circulated to surface.

January 28, 1952, this was bailed dry and tested before drilling was resumed.

Top salt 548'

Water at 425' and raised 310' in hole. (Gyp water)

This work was done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Company.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
