1. Rigged up pulling unit.
2. No 5½" casing present at surface. Installed BOP and stripper head.
3. Tested BOP - tightened flange - retested to 200# - held O. K.
4. Blanked off tubing with tubing disc - trip in hole to 1637' - tbg. stopped at bridge in open hole section at 1637'.
5. Reversed 25 BO and 15 BW from well.
6. Reversed drilled bridge from 1637' - 40' - lost circulation at 1640'.
7. Ran tubing to 1750' - tubing stopped at bridge in open hole section at 1750'.
8. Reverse drilled bridge from 1750' - 55' - received gas kick at 1755' - bled gas to tank and relieved pressure.
9. Ran tubing to 2920' - pumped 7 sx Brinegel in 35 BW.
10. Pumped 102 sx cement @ 2920' without circulation.
11. Pulled bit, drill collars and tubing out of hole.
12. Ran tubing open ended and tagged top of first cement plug @ 2485'.
13. Pulled tubing to 1800' - pumped 3 sx Brinegel in 10 BW.
14. Pumped 35 sx cement @ 1800' without circulation.
15. Tagged top of second cement plug @ 1690' with tubing.
16. Pulled tubing to 1160'.
17. Pumped 8 sx Brinegel in 40 BW in an unsuccessful attempt to gain circulation - shot fluid level @ 60' with Echometer. (cont'd page 2)

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations; and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
