Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

Pulled the rods and tubing and cleaned out well to bottom at 1945'. There was 6' of savings in this well. The pay zone is the lower seven rivers from 1938' to 1945'. After the well was cleaned out we put it back on the pump and took a 7 day test, recovering 70 Bbl's. of oil and no water. This is an average of 10 Bbl's. of oil per 24 hr.
