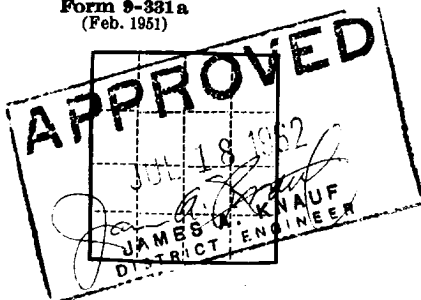

DETAILS OF WORK

On July 15, 1962 we ran 6942' of 5 1/2" OD Std 15.50 mixed Youngstown L&C & Pittsburgh ST&C new JS casing to 6941' and cemented with 350 sacks 50-50 regular and pozzin with 125 gal & 35 salt, 125 sacks 50-50 liner & pozzin 1/2" gal and 17 sacks latex.

On July 16, 1962 we perforated from 6905-6912' and 6914-6917' w/4 jets/ft. Casing and cement withstood 3600 psig during subsequent acid treatment. Cementing was done by Halliburton Company. Perforating was done by Lea-Hills.
