First Sundry Notice was forwarded to the USGS on February 12, 1964 and approved on the 17th. Due to the delay in performing this well work, we wish to submit current intentions. Well records indicate 8 5/8" casing set and cemented at 1257'. Upon re-entry, if we find water shut off from behind the 8 5/8" casing, we may request setting 4 1/2" through the pay, cementing with 100 sacks and perforating. Packer will be installed on 2" tubing and injection will be through tubing completion. If hole conditions are not satisfactory for this completion, 4 1/2" will be cemented to the surface.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
