Gentlemen:

Your Notice of Intention to convert and utilize as a salt water disposal well the No. 23 Jackson "B" on oil and gas lease #24-2742, located 1420/S and 1980/E of sec. 24, T. 17 S., R. 30 E., N.M.P.M., Elly County, New Mexico, by injecting produced waters into the Abo formation is hereby approved subject to approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission prior to commencing disposal and subject to the following:

1. If off-lease waters are to be included in this disposal system, a special land use permit must be secured from the Bureau of Land Management.
2. Where applicable and required, right-of-way permits for pipe lines from other leases must be secured from the Bureau of Land Management prior to laying any water gathering lines from any such leases.
3. Shutty Notice (Form 9-531 in quintuplicate) must be filed with this office prior to commencing any further workover, treatment, suspension of operation, or change of status of the well.
4. A monthly injection report (notice on N.M.O.C.C. form 9-120A acceptable) must be submitted to this office in duplicate.
