Well was cleaned out with rotary tools and reverse circulation to T. D., at 3,281'. 9 jts of 5 1/2" O.D. 14 3/4 J-55 snls casing was run for liner and set from 2,788' to 3,281' total of 293'. Cemented liner with 300 sx class C neat cement. Drilled cement out of liner to 3,279'. WOC 72 hrs. Perforate with Abrasi Jet tool two holes per ft at 3,256', 3,252', 3,238', 3,234', 3,232', 3,212', 3,208'. Ran 5 1/2" Larkin tension packer on 2 3/8" BUL tubing, total of 3,033', and commenced water injection via 2" tubing below packer into perforations 3,256' - 3,208'. Water injection was commenced 5-12-66.

Note - Before liner was ran a Gamma Ray-Neutron and Caliper log was ran and perforations were picked from log.

Cement Job was performed in two stages. One stage consisted of 100 sx in conventional manner from bottom of liner. The second stage consisted of 200 sx in squeeze type operation over top of liner with packer set in 7" casing.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
