Above well drilled by Aston & Fair, July 1942. Records indicate 7" was set & cemented at 2932'.

Intentions are to clean out to T.D. 3300' with reverse circulation. Will install 5 1/2" 15# 8rd. casing as liner, extending from 2875' to 3300' and cemented by squeeze method. Excess cement will be drilled from casing and perforations made at Premier Zone as indicated from Gamma-Ray Neutron Log.

A 5 1/2" tension packer will be run on 2 3/8" tubing and set in tension near the top of the liner. Well will be completed for water injection.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, whether are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
