We reamed hole w/6 1/2" rock bit to 3246 T. D. and circulated to clean hole. Ran 5 1/2" 14# Casing as liner extending from 3082' to 3246'. 50 Sacks cement was pumped beneath and around Liner. 2" tubing was pulled and squeeze packer 7" was set 2950' and 240 sacks cement was squeezed behind Liner from top. Cement drilled out and perforations were made with Abrasi Jet Tool from 3230' to 3240'--2 holes per foot. A 5 1/2" Larkin Tension packer was run on 2" EUE Tubing and set at 3100'. Completed for Water Injection.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
