Cleaned out to 3293' - ran Gamma-Neutron and Caliper logs - set and cemented liner from 3293' to 2900' - let cement set for 72 hours and drilled out excess cement, tested to 2000 psi - perforated with abrasijet 3213-05, and 3160-66 at 2/ft. Treated well with 10,000 gal fresh water and 15,000# sand in each zone - used packer on 2" tubing and retrievable bridge plug to selectively treat each zone. Washed well out, pulled packers, ran tubing and rods and put well on pump. Work completed and well on production on 17 January 1968.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
