Commenced work April 10, 1967.

Fulled 2" tubing & packer. Cleaned well out with rotary tools and reverse circulation to original T. D. at 3,214'. Deepened well w/6 1/2" bit from 3,214' to 3,264' GR. Ran 336' of 4 1/2" O.D. 10.5# J-55 snls 3rd casing for liner using Brown Oil Tool float shoe and liner hanger packer. Set liner from 3,262' to 2,926' and cemented with 300 sx class "C" neat cement. Perforated Liner with sand drill tool 1 hole per ft from 3,226' to 3,219' total of 8 holes. Ran 2 1/2" x 7" Brown Cam-Lock packer and 92 jts of 2 3/8" BHS tubing total of 2,867'. Set packer at 2,867' w/15,000# tension and commenced water injection via 2" tubing into perforations 3,219' to 3,226'. No stimulation was necessary. Work was completed April 24, 1967 and water injection was commenced this date.

Well is taking approximately 600 BWPD at 1420 psig.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
