DETAILS OF WORK

On December 14, 1951, we ran 1917' of 7" OD 20# 8rd thrd new Youngstown seamless casing to 1920' and cemented with 75 sacks of cement preceded by heavy mud to surface.

After standing cemented for 72 hours we drilled plug, bailed hole down and tested shut-off by the bailing method.

As shut-off proved complete drilling was resumed.

Cementing was done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Company.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
