Dear Mr. Beekman:

After our telephone conversation of last week, I have checked our files and found that:

- 1. This well has been erroneously reported on Form C 120-A as plugged and abandoned. The May report will be corrected; the well is no longer in use, but has not been plugged.
- 2. The well was converted to injection service 12/20/68 (NMOCC Order No. R-3580). Permission was granted on 3/23/71, by NMOCC Order No. R-4120 to discontinue use of this well and dispose of lease produced water into an unlined surface pit.

I have requested that our District Engineering Department investigate the feasibility of returning the well to producing status, selling the well bore (since we do not own all depth rights under this location), or plugging. Our decision should be made by June 1. Of course it will then take some time to complete action on either of the alternatives.
