This well was commenced on March 19, 1952 and completed on April 6, 1952. On March 24, 1952, 488' of 8 3/8" and the casing was run and cemented. In April 6, 1952 1850' of 7" and the seamless casing was run and all of 8 3/8" casing was pulled. The 7" casing was cemented with 175 sacks of cement by Burlington Oil Well Cementing Company.

It is of the greatest importance to have a complete history of the well. Please state in detail the dates of redrilling, together with the reasons for the work and its results. If there were any changes made in the casing, state fully, and if any casing was "sidetracked" or left in the well, give its size and location.
