On August 15, 1951, at T₀ 2351', we ran 230.60' of 5 1/2" OD 11# 8rd thrd used casing as a liner hung from 2618.40' to 2848.00' with a Baash-Ross model #131 liner hanger equipped with two lead pack-off rings. Liner was cemented with 75 sacks of cement by the Denton Oil Well Cementing Company.

After standing for 72 hours plug was drilled and shut-off tested satisfactory by the bailing method.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
