DETAILS OF WORK

On March 23, 1952, we ran 473.20' (11 Joints) of 8-5/8" OD 24# 8rd thrd range 3 J-55 new Youngstown seamless casing to 482' and cemented with 50 sacks cement preceded by heavy mud to surface.

After allowing to stand cemented for 72 hours, we drilled plug, bailed hole down and tested water shut-off by bailing method. As shut-off proved complete drilling was resumed.

Cementing was done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Company.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
