1. Rigged up pulling unit, pulled rods and tubing.
2. Ran 4 1/2" Guiberson Uni-one Packer on 2 3/8" plastic lined tubing and set at 2899'.
3. Loaded casing annulus with fresh water and chemical.
4. Equipped well for injection and commenced water injection Sept. 18, 1976 in accordance with N. M. O. C. C. Order R-5224 dated June 1, 1976.

Note: Pressure tests will be conducted to determine the pressure at which injection into said well may be maintained without causing fracturing of the cement or formation around the well and resultant migration.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
