DETAILS OF WORK

On August 15, 1951 we set 485' of 8 5/8" casing using 50 sacks of cement and 10 sacks of aquagel, by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company.

On September 21, 1951 we set 2763.96' of 7" casing using 100 sacks of cement and 10 sacks of aquagel, by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company.

On September 25, 1951 we shot this well with 100 qts. of solidified glycerine using shot gravel and oil for tamping, by Independent-Eastern Torpedo Company.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
