FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On about June 7, 1945, plan to plug well as follows: Using Halliburton Oilwell cementing Equipment, run tubing to total depth, 3160', and circulated 125 sacks of mud to the surface. Pull tubing up to 2924' and spot 15 sacks of cement from 2924 to approximately 2850', throughout the Loco Hills Pay Horizon. Pull tubing up to 1200' and spot 10 sacks plug at base of salt. Remove tubing from hole, and screw 8" bull plug in top of 8" casing, leaving 5061 of 8 5/8" casing in the hole.
