On April 2, 1945, plan to dump, using Halliburton Dump Bailer Service, 50' cement from 2867, the total depth, to 2817; and to proceed as diligently as possible, after mudding the hole, to recover all 7 and 8" casing possible. A 10 sack cement plug will be set in the mud column at the base of the salt, & the top of the salt, and at the surface, and a regulation marker set.
