DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On June 1, 1943, at Total Depth 2962, Bridged Back to 2845 and shot with 150 quarts Nitroglycerin from 2818 to 2845. After shot cleaned out to 2845 and swabbed 80 Bbls. oil in 22 hours.

On June 5, 1943, at Total Depth 2962, Bridged Back to 2620 and shot with 140 quarts Nitroglycerin from 2570 to 2620. After shot cleaned out to Plugged Back Depth 2865 and well swabbed ~~100~~ and flowed 150 Bbls. oil in 20 hours.
