FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On December 19th, 1945, the hole was bridged back to 3010' and casing gun perforated with four holes at 2979', and on December 28th, casing was perforated with ten additional holes, 2980' to 2964'. On January 31st, 1946, the casing was cemented with 100 sack of Portland cement. Bottom of casing, 2994' cement plug stopped at 2912'. 1200# pressure on pump. Cement plug was drilled and well cleaned out. We propose to test casing shutoff by shutting well in and allow gas pressure to build up.
